Unit 4 Citizenship Campaign

Activities linked to KS4 Programme of Study

- Edexcel provides generic tasks for the eight key areas.
- Centres need to contextualize and expand these tasks to meet local needs.
- Tasks will be reviewed by Edexcel every two years.
- Students submitting a controlled assessment for Unit 4 must complete one of the proposed campaigns,
- It is acceptable for students in a class to all complete the same activity, or students could complete different tasks provided all students received equitable levels of support.
- Students may submit tasks for Unit 2 and Unit 4 from the same key area.

- **Political, legal and human rights and responsibilities - (a), (k)**

Unit 4 A campaign to raise awareness about access, eg for the disabled/mothers pushchairs and young children in the community.

- **The law, its enforcement and the operation of democracy - (b)**
Unit 4 A campaign to raise awareness about crime/anti-social behaviour and its impact on the local community.

- **Active citizenship in a democracy - (c)**
Unit 4 A campaign to raise awareness of issues affecting a local community, eg access to shopping, nuisances

- **Ways to influence decisions locally, nationally and globally - (d), (e), (h)**

Unit 4 A campaign to influence decisions relating to proposed changes in local provision/services, eg youth centre, post office, schools threatened by falling roles

- **The development of rights and freedom eg association, opinion, speech - (f).**
Unit 4 A campaign to raise awareness about racism in school/wider community.
- **The impact of the media and the influence of pressure groups - (g)**
Unit 4 A campaign to raise awareness about shortage of volunteers in a specific area of community activity using a range of media
- **Diversity and the changing nature of society - (l)**
Unit 4 A campaign to encourage local councils/voluntary organisations to meet the needs of ethnic groups in the community.
- **Global challenges including the economy, disagreements, inequalities and sustainable development - (j), (l), (m), (n)**
Unit 4 A campaign to raise awareness about the role and function of Fair Trade and the availability of Fair Trade products.
