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### 1 Key Dates

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GCSE and International GCSE examinations are normally held in the June examination series with limited subject availability in the November and January examination series respectively.

GCSE 360Science units are available in the November, March and June examination series.

Applied GCSE (Double Award) examinations are normally held in January and June. Portfolio moderation takes place in May only.

## 8 The Edexcel Certificate: June 2012 Availability

### 8.1 Introduction

The Secretary of State announced in the summer of 2010 that in future state schools would be able to offer their students International GCSEs. Following this, a number of state schools made June 2011 examination entries for Edexcel's international International GCSEs, which are not accredited by Ofqual. In response, we consulted extensively with centres and have since been working with the regulator Ofqual to gain accreditation for a selection of our International GCSEs (called Edexcel Certificates) for use in UK state schools.

We have submitted our International GCSEs in **mathematics, English, sciences, history, geography, French, German, Chinese and Spanish** for accreditation as Edexcel Certificates to reflect the current demand in schools. Our new Edexcel Certificate qualifications are based on our International GCSE specifications' content.

### 8.3 Information for exams officers

Examination results for International GCSE will not be recognised in performance tables, so examination entries should be made for Edexcel Certificates.

Entry codes differ for International GCSE and Certificate, with International GCSE codes beginning with the number 4 and Certificates with the letter K.
