1 How to apply for Post-results Services

Please note that Enquiries About Results and Access to Scripts requests can only be submitted using Edexcel Online. Centres are advised to submit applications at the earliest opportunity, as applications cannot be made after the published closing date.


All applications submitted will be automatically acknowledged online. An additional confirmation email will be sent to the Edexcel Online user's registered email address confirming receipt of the request. If an email acknowledgement is not received on the same day an application is made, please contact Edexcel *immediately*.

How to use Edexcel Online to submit Post-Results Services (PRS) requests

Log into www.edexcelonline.com and then select the relevant qualification from the tabs available.

From the menus on the left hand side select 'Post Results'.

Type the unit code into the 'Unit' field. Click the 'Submit' button and Edexcel Online will then check to see if the service you have selected is applicable to the unit you have chosen. For example, if you select an internally assessed coursework unit code and request an EAR2, the system will tell you that this is not possible.

If the PRS service you have chosen can be applied to your chosen unit, then it will show you a list of candidates at your centre who sat that unit; please note that if you request an EAR3 (a review of the moderation of the original sample of coursework material), a list of candidates will not be shown. This is because you cannot request an EAR3 for an individual candidate.

Here is an example of the screen you will see showing the candidates who sat a particular examination:

Here is an example of the screen you will see if you try to submit an EAR3 type request (re-moderation of the coursework sample) for a written examination paper:

Once you have the list of candidates who sat a particular paper, you simply select the candidate (or candidates) for whom you want to apply for a particular PRS service and then click the 'Submit' button.

Edexcel Online does a check to see if there is more than one paper attached to this unit code. That's why the next screen allows you to select which of the papers you want re-marking, if there is more than one.

3 Introduction

- This document should be read in conjunction with the Joint Council for Qualifications (JCQ) *Post-results Services Information and Guidance for Centres* booklet relating to:
 - Enquiries About Results – Post-results review of marking services
 - Access to Scripts – copied script service and original script service.
- Amendments to requests received after the deadline will not be accepted. Incorrect or incomplete information diverts significant resources from other enquiries. This policy has been introduced to ensure that Post-results Services are effective for all centres.
- A full list of services available for individual components with notes, where appropriate, is available in part 10 of this section of the manual.
- Please refer to part 4.6 of this section of the manual for detailed information regarding extensions to Post-results reviews of marking.
- All applications submitted online will be automatically acknowledged online. A confirmation email acknowledging receipt of the application will be sent to the Edexcel Online user's registered email address.
- It is essential that examination officers retain and check their acknowledgements regarding any enquiry service. If acknowledgement is not received on the day an application is made, the centre must contact Edexcel to confirm that the enquiry has been opened. If this procedure is not followed, a late enquiry cannot be opened. A call log number will be given to the examinations officer. This will provide the centre with evidence of their query if needed at a later stage.
- Submission deadlines must be met. The deadlines published are for *receipt* of the enquiry or request for ATS at Edexcel. *No exceptions to the agreed submission deadlines can be granted.*

4 Result enquiry services

4.1 EAR Service 1: clerical re-check

This service constitutes a re-check of all clerical procedures which lead to the issue of a result. This service might be considered when anomalous results have been issued for one candidate, compared to the rest of the cohort.

Please refer to the JCQ Post-results Services booklet for detailed information regarding the regulations with respect to this service.

This service includes the following checks:

- all parts of the script have been marked
- the totalling of marks
- the recording of marks
- the application of any adjustments
- the application of grade thresholds.

Candidates' grades or uniform mark score (UMS) can go up or down.

We aim to complete the enquiry within 20 days of acknowledging the request.

Please refer to part 10 in this section of the manual for details of Service 1 clerical re-check availability.

4.2 EAR Service 2: Post-results review of marking of externally assessed components

This service will include:

- the clerical re-checks(EAR Service 1)
- the review of marking of units/components by a senior examiner
- if requested, a copy of the reviewed script(s) for those components included in ATS. A fee is levied for this additional service.

Note: This service is not available for internally assessed and externally moderated coursework. Please see Service 3 notes (part 4.4) for this type of component. Please also refer to the JCQ Post-results Service booklet for detailed information regarding the regulations with respect to this service.

Please refer to part 10 of this section of the manual for details of Service 2 availability for units/components. Ensure that you have specified the *paper code* as well as the *unit code* for any Service 2 application.

Candidates' grades or uniform mark scores (UMS) can go up or down.

- Please note that Service 2 is available to individual candidates.
- Results for each candidate will be reported separately.

If a centre has particular concerns regarding the marking of a component in general, refer to part 4.6 of this section of the manual for information regarding extensions to Enquiries About Results.

Please note that additional component EAR requests, subsequent to an initial request, will delay communication of the outcome of the original request as the new additional component(s) will be added to the previously started ongoing request.

We aim to complete the enquiry within 30 days of acknowledging the request.

4.3 EAR Priority Service 2 (2P): Post-results review of marking of externally assessed components

This post-results review of marking service offers the same services as outlined above but we aim to complete the enquiry within 18 days of acknowledging the request. This service is only available if the following criteria are met:

- the enquiry is about a GCE, AEA or Principal Learning Level 3
- a candidate's place in further/higher education depends on the outcome
- applications must be submitted before the deadline to receive Priority Service 2 applications.

All applications not meeting the above criteria will be treated as normal Service 2 requests.

4.4 EAR Service 3: Post-results review of moderation of internally assessed/externally moderated coursework components

This service constitutes a review of moderation of a centre's coursework by a senior moderator. The service is not available to individual candidates. Please refer to the JCQ Post-results Service booklet for detailed information regarding the regulations with respect to this service.

Please note that candidates' marks may be lowered following a review of moderation, but their published subject grades will NOT be lowered in the series concerned. However, centres should be aware that a lowered mark may be carried forward to future certification. For example, if a coursework mark which contributes to an AS award is lowered as a result of review of moderation, the AS grade will be protected, but the lower mark will contribute to any subsequent A level award.

The review of moderation will:

- be undertaken on the original sample of candidates' work and will replicate the original moderation procedure
- not be undertaken for the work of an individual candidate or for the work of candidates not in the original sample
- include feedback similar to that provided following the original moderation
- not be undertaken when the centre's coursework marks were accepted at the original moderation.

Coursework submitted for review of moderation must:

- be despatched to Edexcel **within three working days** of the Service 3 review of moderation request – failure to meet this undertaking will delay the outcome of the enquiry. If any work is not received within 10 days of the Service 3 review of moderation request, the enquiry will be closed
- be the original work submitted for moderation
- have been kept under secure conditions and not returned to the candidates.

Note: Address details will be confirmed upon receipt of your application. Where the centre does not provide the original sample of work, the enquiry will be closed without review of moderation taking place.

We aim to complete the enquiry within 40 days of the moderator receiving the original coursework sample from the centre or, in the case of Art and Design, 40 days of either the receipt of the work from the centre or 40 days of the centre visit.

Please refer to part 10 of this section of the manual for details of Service 3 availability for units/components. The centre must specify the component to be reviewed.

This service cannot be undertaken on ephemeral units unless suitable evidence (such as video evidence) can be provided. Please see the specification/component listings in part 10 of this section of the manual for details.

Centres are advised to retain a copy of each candidate's work before despatch. If work is lost in the post and a second copy of the original sample is not available, the enquiry will be closed.

4.5 Access to Scripts (ATS)

Where possible, the ATS service is available for all GCE, AEA and GCSE/IGCSE externally assessed components. Components may be excluded due to their ephemeral nature or due to other special characteristics.

Please check part 10 of this section of the manual for component availability before completing an ATS request. For all GCE requests please ensure that the component is specified.

Once scripts have been despatched, or electronic copies of scripts in a PDF format have been made available, they cannot be returned to Edexcel with a request for a refund.

Copied scripts

Copied scripts are only available for GCE, AEA and Principal Learning Level 3 units, and are used by centres to allow them to make a decision on whether to go ahead with an EAR Service 2 request.

Please note that these advance copy services are NOT available if requesting Priority Service 2 Enquiries About Results. If a candidate requests a Priority Service 2 Enquiry about Results, an application for a photocopy script must not be made. Centres should progress straight to a Priority Service 2 Enquiry about Results.

Original scripts

An original script service is available for all components with an ATS facility.

Please note that Edexcel cannot provide original scripts for papers that were marked online. Instead, an electronic copy of the script in PDF format will be made available to the centre.

Once an original script has been returned to a centre its security is compromised and it can no longer be subject to an enquiry or investigation.

Original scripts/PDFs will not be made available to centres before the deadline for receipt of Enquiries About Results. Centres may however request copies of reviewed scripts at the same time as requesting an Enquiry About Results.

Where appropriate, examiners may write comments on traditionally marked scripts indicating the way in which candidates have met the requirements of the marking scheme. Examiners are asked to refer scripts to a more senior examiner where they are doubtful about how to apply the mark scheme. A script might have a note to that effect.

Scripts marked online do not show any comments when they are returned to centres.

Please refer to the JCQ Post-results Services booklet for detailed information regarding access to scripts and the use of script material for teaching purposes.

4.6 Extensions to Enquiries About Results

Where Edexcel is satisfied that an EAR has revealed a demonstrable trend of significant under-marking of a centre cohort, it will seek to address the issue via an 'extended review of marking'. Such an extended review of marking may take one of the following courses of action as appropriate:

- a partial extended review of marking of candidates' entire scripts, or of selected questions or sections of a paper
- a total extended review of marking of all candidates in the centre cohort
- a statistical adjustment to the raw marks of the remaining candidates.

Edexcel monitors the outcome of all EARs. However, if a centre feels there is a demonstrable trend of significant under-marking on a paper, it must raise the matter with Edexcel within 14 days of the receipt of the last relevant review of marking result confirmation.

Edexcel will authorise an extended review of marking only if it accepts that a demonstrable trend of significant under-marking has been revealed. 'Significant under-marking' is generally defined as a change of more than 5% of the raw mark total of the paper (not the UMS).

We hold the following criteria in mind when deciding upon an extended review of marking:

- review of marking evidence is required from paid requests from a representative sample of 10% of the centre's cohort

- the sample should be a minimum of eight candidates. In the case of very large centre entries where 10% would be more than 20, centres need not submit more than 20 requests for reviews of marking
- at least 50% of the reviewed sample must have experienced significant under-marking
- subject grade changes will not be used as a criterion to determine whether an Enquiry About Results should be extended.
- the evidence of one EAR cannot be accepted as a trend

Where Edexcel initiates an extended review of marking, candidates' marks and subject grades may only be confirmed or raised; marks and subject grades will not be lowered. Where Edexcel initiates an extended review of marking, centres will not be charged a fee.

Where Edexcel initiates an extended review of marking, centres will not be invoiced for those reviews requested as part of the 'representative sample'.

5 Appeals

Following receipt of the outcome of an EAR, the centre may wish to appeal against the decision if they remain dissatisfied. The head of centre (or designated member of the centre's senior management team or examinations manager) will be allowed 14 calendar days from the receipt of the outcome of the EAR during which an appeal may be lodged by writing to the following address:

Appeals cannot be accepted directly from candidates, their parents or other third parties acting on their behalf. However, private candidates may appeal directly without the support of the entering centre.

Appeals may only be lodged on the basis of whether the awarding body used procedures which were consistent with the regulatory authorities' Code of Practice, and applied its procedures properly and fairly in arriving at judgements. The appeals office may refuse to accept an appeal if no procedural grounds are specified.

The procedures which are open to investigation include the full range of processes involved in and leading to the award of grades: the setting of papers; marking and moderation; the grade award and EARs and administrative arrangements.

Note: The appeals process is not directly concerned with making judgements about the quality of candidates' work, as this is the responsibility of senior examiners and moderators. Appeals do not normally involve the further review of marking or moderation of work, unless the initial appeals investigation suggests that procedures were not followed during the EAR.

Centres may also appeal against decisions taken by Edexcel concerning special consideration cases, including cases where an aegrotat award has been made, and access arrangements. In these cases, the centre may contact the appeals office directly, without first requesting an EAR.

When an appeal is lodged, Edexcel will carry out a preliminary appeals investigation. This will take the form of a fresh examination of all available evidence and may involve research officers, subject-related assessment staff and senior examining personnel. The EAR files and other relevant records will also be inspected for accuracy.

Each letter of appeal will be acknowledged within two working days of receipt, at which time further written guidance on the Edexcel appeals process will be provided. A letter, summarising the

results of the initial appeals investigation, will normally be sent within 21 calendar days of receipt of the letter of appeal. In the event that the appeals office is unable to complete its enquiries within 21 days, the centre will be advised of the likely extent of any delay.

If, following the initial investigation, the centre remains dissatisfied with Edexcel's response, the head of centre may request the opportunity to present the case in person at a hearing of the Edexcel appeals panel. If, following an appeal hearing, the centre remains dissatisfied, it may submit an appeal to the independent Examinations Appeals Board (EAB).

Centres will normally be expected to contribute towards the costs of appeal investigations and hearings. The maximum amounts that will be charged are £120 per examination component for the initial appeal investigation, and £150 for any subsequent appeal hearing. There is no requirement for any fee to be submitted with the initial letter of appeal.

Centres will not be charged for special consideration appeals, and will not be charged for other appeals if the appeal is upheld.

6 Missing and Incomplete Results

Edexcel will provide an explanation on any of the following result reports without charge, once a centre has made a Missing and Incomplete Results (MIR) enquiry. We accept MIRs for all candidates over the telephone (see the Contact Information section of this manual for details). The following MIRs are shown on results documentation:

- no result (shown as an 'X' on the results report)
- a result awarded on incomplete examination evidence (shown as a '#' sign on the results report)
- result pending (shown as a 'Q' on the results report)
- no result possible (shown as a 'Y' on the results report).

Please make sure you note your call reference number when making a MIR enquiry. This number should be quoted in all subsequent telephone calls relating to the MIR.

Missing/incorrect coursework marks

Amendments to missing or incorrect coursework unit marks may be made until the deadline for EAR Service 3 in the relevant examination series. To update an incorrect mark the examinations officer at the centre should email coursework@edexcel.com stating the centre number, unit and candidate details, and details of the mark(s) to be amended. An explanation for the change must be included with the request, and further evidence may be requested when amendments are unduly large or being made for several candidates on the same unit. Note that email mark amendments are only accepted from a recognised centre email address. Emails from web-based (hotmail, yahoo etc) or other email servers are not accepted for mark amendments. This same information may be faxed by the examinations officer on centre letterhead to 020 7190 5608.

Cancellation fee

If the cancellation of an EAR Service 2 or Service 2P Post-results review of marking is requested after processing of the EAR has begun but before the EAR is completed, there will be a cancellation fee equal to 50% of the original fee. If the cancellation request is received after completion of the EAR, the full fees shown above will apply.

Waiving of EAR fees

Centres will not be invoiced for EARs in the following circumstances:

- for candidates who have cashed-in (ie, have been awarded an overall subject grade in the subject concerned), fees will not be incurred where the EAR leads to a change in the overall subject grade for that candidate

Please note that a late request to claim an award will incur a fee.

9 Subject specific information

9.1 GCE Art and Design GCSE Art and Design

Please note that only EAR Service 3 is available for these specifications.

Centres should submit EAR requests to Edexcel via Edexcel Online. After receipt of the EAR request, Edexcel will fax the centre an acknowledgement letter. The original sample of candidates will be listed in this letter, and their work must be available for review of moderation for the request to be valid. Edexcel will make arrangements for a senior moderator to visit the centre.

Centres must notify Edexcel upon receipt of the list of sampled candidates.

Centres will be liable for all associated costs, which will be calculated pro rata on the basis of the number of candidates who meet the criteria (listed in part 7 of this section of the manual). In cases where a senior moderator visits the centre, this includes the senior moderator's fees, travelling expenses, subsistence costs and, if necessary, accommodation costs and teacher-release payments. The centre will not, however, be required to pay the standard Service 3 fees in addition.

In cases where the review of moderation of work is at Edexcel, standard Service 3 fees will apply, in addition to all postage and packaging costs.

The original sample per unit/paper across endorsements must be available for the request to be valid. It is possible to request an EAR on one unit or paper only, but review of moderation will not be undertaken on the work of one endorsement only in centres entered for multiple endorsements.

In cases where a centre visit takes place, if the requested sample is not available the senior moderator will withdraw from the centre. The original moderation decision will be upheld and the centre will be liable for the payment of all associated costs.

Candidates' marks may be confirmed, lowered or raised but candidates' consent is *not* required by Edexcel for Service 3 Enquiries About Results.

Centres will be informed of the outcome of their EAR request within 40 days of either the receipt of the work at the coursework centre or within 40 days of the centre visit. Centres will also receive a report giving feedback similar to that provided following the original moderation. Centres are reminded that work must not be returned to candidates until after the EAR deadline has passed.

9.2 GCE Drama GCSE Drama

For GCE Drama unit 2 (6DR02), GCSE 2009 Drama 5DR03 and IGCSE Drama 4348, an application for an Enquiry About Results (EAR) will only be accepted if a recording of the performance was supplied to the examiner *within seven working days of the performance*.

Note: The application for an Enquiry About Results request will be cancelled and closed, if a recording of the performance was not supplied to the original examiner within seven working days of the performance.

The standard fee for this Service 2 Post-results review of marking is *£51.50 per candidate*.

Note: Centres can also request a copy of the examiner's notes for GCE Drama unit 2 (6DR02), which is available via the ATS service. A fee is levied for this ATS service.

9.3 GCE Modern Foreign Languages GCSE Modern Foreign Languages

For GCE Modern Foreign Language oral units, tapes are held at our processing centre and will be returned to centres after the EAR deadline. It is of great help in getting EARs closed promptly if centres submit all EAR requests pertaining to a language at the same time.

For externally assessed GCSE Modern Foreign Language oral components, the centre must despatch the oral tape(s) to the address below *within three days* of the submission of an EAR request.

If the oral tape(s) is/are not received *within five days* of the Service 2 Post-results review of marking request, the enquiry will be cancelled and closed.

If a centre is not in possession of the oral tape(s), please contact the Post-results team immediately.

A list of the candidate(s) for whom an EAR has been requested should be included with the tapes. However, this does not apply to the following GCSE languages - Arabic, Chinese, Japanese, Modern Greek and Russian - as tapes will already be held at our processing centre.
