*Assessor to read out the following instruction:*

**You are at the hospital. You need to find Ward 5. Using the map, listen and follow the directions. When I give you directions, for example when I say 'walk', can you do this using a pen or finger on the map?**

- 2a. *The assessor to ask the candidate:*  
**"You see me in front of you. I'm a doctor. Ask me for directions."**
  
- 2b. *The assessor to ask the candidate:*  
**"Look at the map. Can you show me where you are starting from?"**
  
- 2c. *The assessor to ask the candidate:*  
**"Now walk forward and take the first turning on your right. Stop and show me where you are now? (If the candidate is at the wrong place put them back on track before the next set of directions)."**
  
- 2d. *The assessor to ask the candidate:*  
**"OK, let's continue. Walk forward then turn left. Continue walking forwards past the X-ray department. After this department turn right. Ward 5 is in front of you. Tell me when you have found it?"**

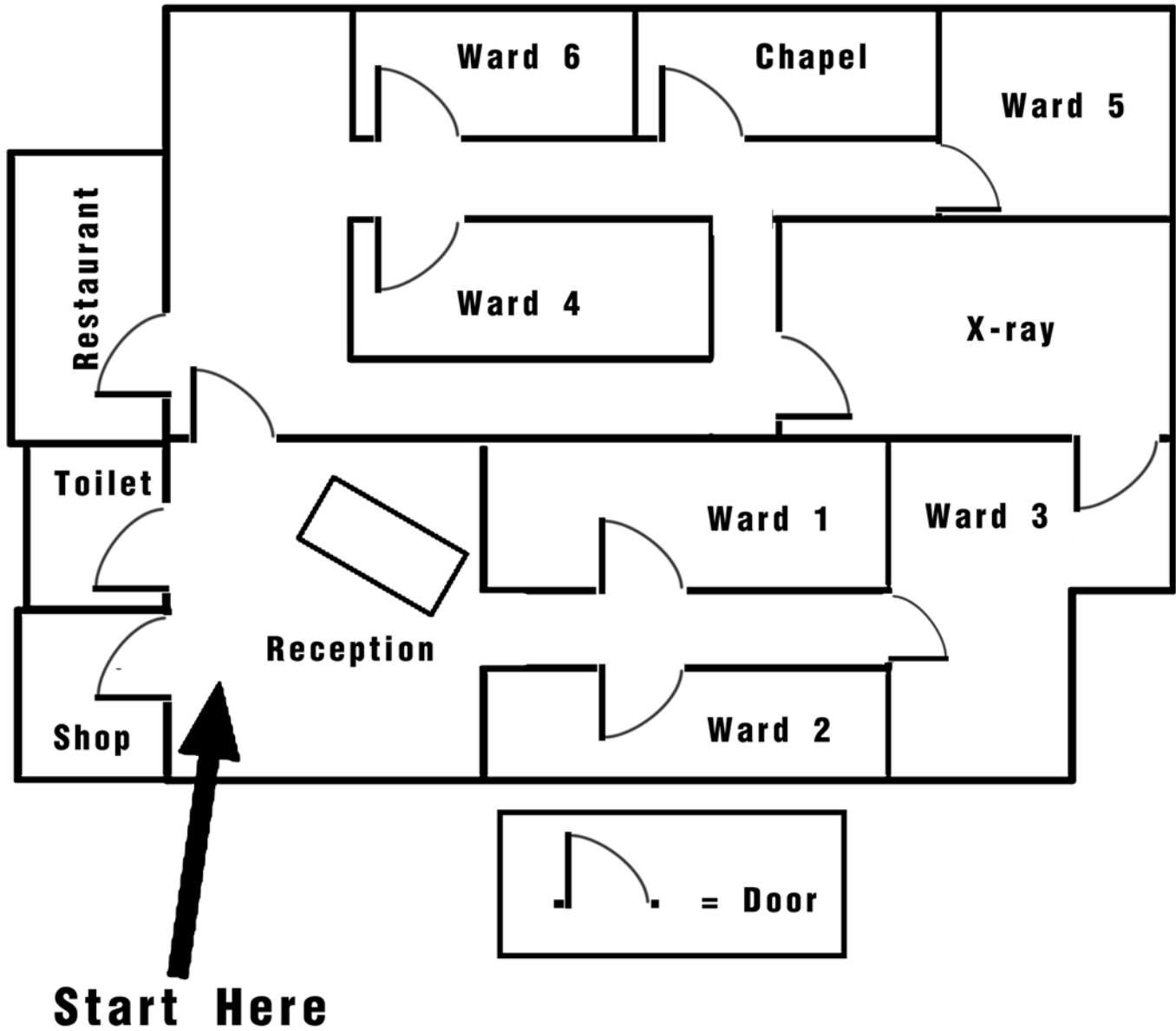
