Student Guide Level 2 BTEC First Diploma

What is the Level 2 BTEC First Diploma in Business?

The business world comprises an enormous variety of different careers. The BTEC First Diploma in Business aims to provide you with a practical appreciation of what "being in business" entails, and it will help you to develop the understanding and competency needed when considering entering employment in this sector.

The course is designed to enable you to study other subjects alongside your BTEC First Diploma. There are three core units plus a choice of specialist units totalling 360 guided learning hours. Depending on the locally available programme of study, the course is structured to permit you to develop your existing interests as well as giving you a broad foundation and introducing you to new areas in the business sector, such as business communication, starting a small business or developing customer relations.

Where will this qualification take me?

Employment opportunities

Following completion of the BTEC First Diploma in Business, successful candidates would be able to enter initial employment, at a junior level, in such areas as administration assistance or telesales operations.

Further vocational and academic qualifications

The BTEC First Diploma has the equivalence of 4 GCSEs graded A*-C. If you achieve an overall pass grade or better in the BTEC First Diploma in Business, it is possible for you to enrol on another Level 2 programme, such as a relevant NVQ, or to move on to a higher level qualification such as a Level 3 BTEC National Certificate in Business.

How long will it take me to complete this qualification?

Generally speaking, it will take one academic year to complete but it may be studied for shorter or longer periods; the length of the course is largely dependant on the centre where you study.

What are the entry requirements?

The entry requirements for the Edexcel Level 2 BTEC First Diploma in Business are laid down by individual centres. You should have the interest and potential to succeed in achieving the qualification and ideally be able to show you have a standard of literacy, numeracy and general education equivalent to four GCSEs graded D-G, or you should be able to show you have undertaken suitable work experience or have completed a Level 1 or 2 qualification.
