

## Diploma Assessment And Awarding

### Diploma Awarding

Edexcel will award the Foundation and Higher Diplomas in the first five lines of learning for the first time in summer 2009 and the second five lines of learning in 2010.

In line with Ofqual regulations, Advanced Diplomas will be awarded one year behind the first awarding dates of the Foundation and Higher Diplomas.

### Principal Learning

Edexcel will be making selected units available for assessment in January 2010 for the second five lines of learning and all units from the first five lines of learning will be available.

*First five Lines of Principal Learning*- In line with Ofqual regulations, levels 1 and 2 Principal Learning qualifications will be awarded for the first time in summer 2009, whilst level 3 Principal Learning qualifications will be awarded for the first time in Summer 2010.

*Second five lines of Principal Learning* - In line with Ofqual regulations, levels 1 and 2 Principal Learning qualifications will be awarded for the first time in summer 2010, whilst level 3 Principal Learning qualifications will be awarded for the first time in summer 2011
