VISIT / ISSUE REPORT CONSULTANCY SERVICE

Even though the visit / issue reports are marked by Edexcel during the examination period, it is useful for centres to appreciate what makes a good visit / issue report.

Therefore, during the year, a centre may send up to **THREE EXAMPLES** of reports electronically (with their recommended marks) to the Qualification Delivery & Awarding Manager for GCE Biology (SNAB) at damian.riddle@edexcel.org.uk. (You may wish to send one piece of work that you think is high scoring and one/two pieces of work that you think are in the mid-range.)

It may be more useful, especially with larger files, to send the reports on CD to Damian Riddle, QDAM for GCE Biology (SNAB), 5th floor, Edexcel, 190 High Holborn, London WC1V 7BH.

Your marks/assessments should be recorded, with reasons and other evidence, using the INFORMATION GRID on the back page of this pamphlet, which can also be found at <http://www.edexcel.org.uk/quals/gce/biology/as/8048/>. The work will be sent to a Senior Moderator, who will usually reply within two weeks, but up to four weeks should be allowed. You will benefit most from this service if the information grid is fully completed, as the Senior Moderator will be able to focus on your comments.

NB The Senior Moderator will be unable to comment on work that has not been assessed.

You will not be charged a fee for this service.

The samples can be sent at any time during the year but work intended for submission in May should be sent by 31st March.

**The work submitted to Edexcel will not be returned to you
so please keep a copy on disc within the centre.**

Please note that work submitted to Edexcel may be used as exemplar material (as is the case with coursework submitted for moderation).
