

Structure of the Edexcel Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Barbering (QCF)

To achieve the Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Barbering (QCF), the learner must achieve a minimum of 37 credits.

- Learners must take six mandatory units (28 credits).
- Learners must achieve a minimum of 9 credits from **Optional group A** and **B**. At least one unit must be taken from the **Optional group A** and at least one unit must be taken from the **Optional group B**.
