Unit 2b

Final assessment of coursework

In making final assessments for each student's coursework marks, the teacher will reconsider all of the evidence listed on the Coursework Coversheet for Unit 2B.

Tasks assessing reading and writing are equally weighted. The two pieces assessed for Reading, Response to Different Cultures and Traditions and Response to Poetry, are weighted at 7.5% each; the one piece assessed for writing, Writing to explore, imagine and entertain, is weighted at 15%.

When making final assessment of the reading and writing coursework at the end of the course, the teacher will need to identify the separate evidence for the reading assignments and for the writing assignments in order to award separate marks for Reading and Writing for the portfolio.

For the reading assignments teachers should award a single mark out of 40 using the marking grid on pages 69-71.

For the writing assignment, teachers should use the appropriate assessment grids for writing on pages 72-73 and arrive at a mark out of 40.

Finally, teachers should provide a single mark (Reading and Writing together) out of 40 for Paper 2B.
