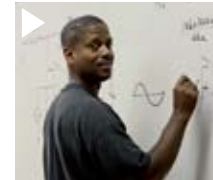

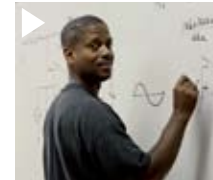
### Improved **BTECs** from September 2010

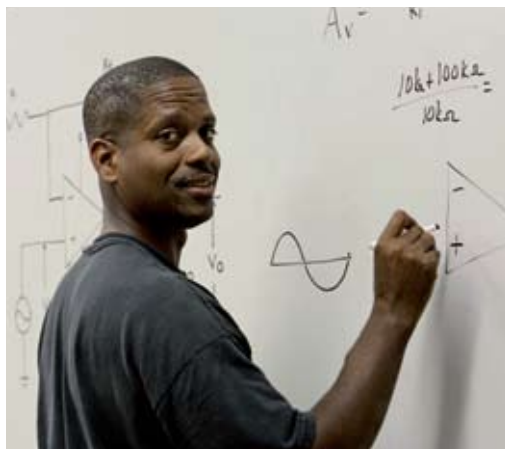

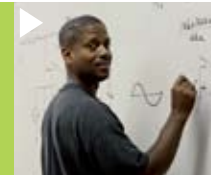
### Joined up, work-ready qualifications

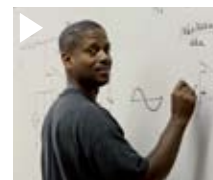

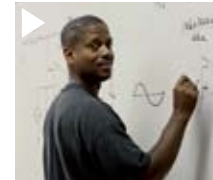

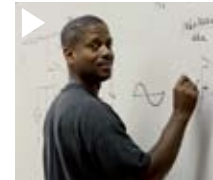
## QCF alignment – what you need to know
