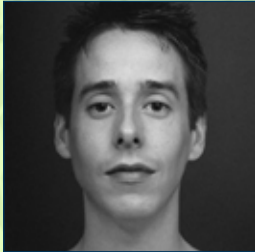
### **Emma Clark**
