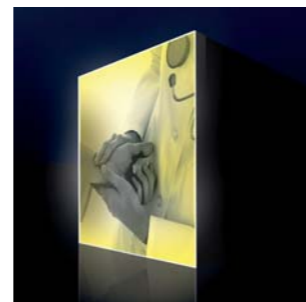


Coming soon – Resources from Edexcel for the 14-19 Diploma in Society, Health and Development

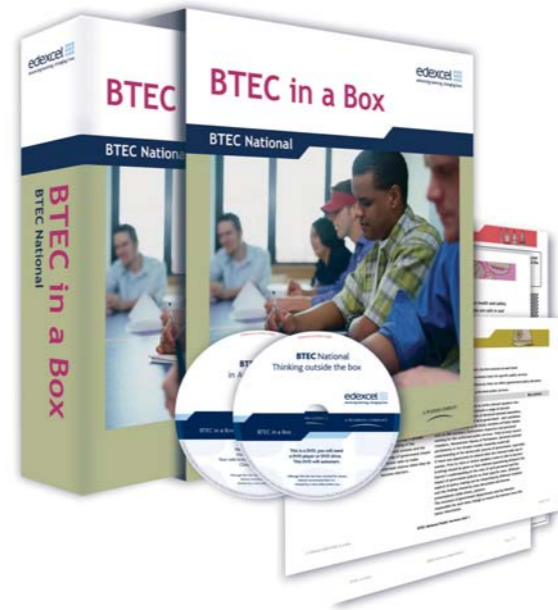

It is important that learners understand how policy and procedures are instigated and implemented. They need to understand the influence of key research and legislation on practice. Ask learners to look at policies and procedures from different settings and present their findings to the rest of the group. Get learners to identify the key legislation and research that has influenced the policy and procedures they have looked at.
