For Functional Skills, you may release results to students from Thursday 22 December 2011. We expect many schools and colleges only to release these in January.

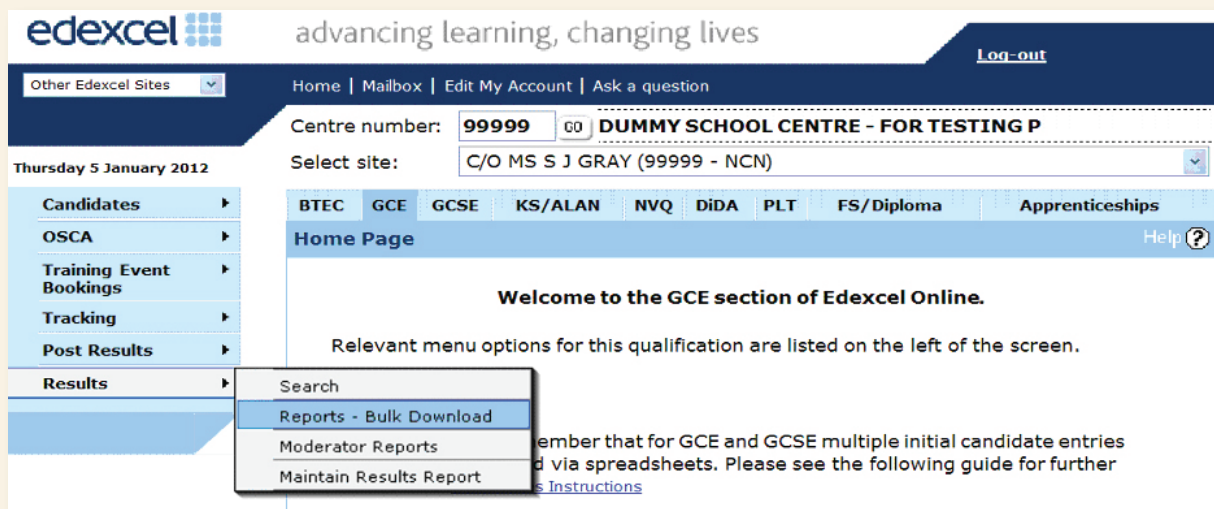
You can provide results to your students in a variety of ways, depending upon your centre's preference and agreed arrangements:

- By downloading results via EDI and producing paper copies from your MIS
- By downloading results from Edexcel Online

The dates on which results become available in each of these formats (and when they may be passed onto students) are shown in the table above.

You can view student results and access reports at www.edexcelonline.com.

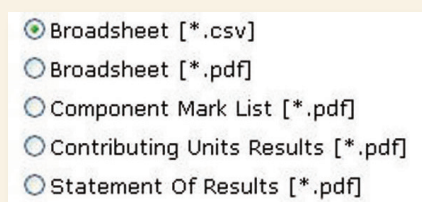


Individual student results

Click on “search”, and enter the details of the candidate and click search.

Reports including Certifying Statements of Provisional Results

Click on “reports - bulk downloads”, select the session and then the report type required.



Once requested, reports will be delivered to your Edexcel Online mailbox within two hours. The reports can be used in various different ways. Below is a summary of each report and a suggestion of how you might use them:

Report name	Used for	Contains
Broadsheet	Checking student performance at-a-glance.	All unit level scores and overall subject grades
Component Mark List	Checking student performance against grade boundaries (also useful for teachers and heads of departments).	Listed by component, shows: subject marks, UMS, maximum raw and weighted marks.
Contributing Units Results	Checking how raw unit marks contributed to each UMS (also useful for teachers and heads of departments).	Grades, component unit scores, total UMS and grade boundaries.
Statement of results	Providing results information to students. It details overall grades and contributing units.	Shows grades for all subjects and scores for each unit.

EDI Files

Our EDI results files are in the latest JCQ format (currently version 14). This format is used by all the JCQ Awarding Bodies.

If you wish to be sent a new or revised EDI file, we can arrange this for you. Please contact us at eprocessing@edexcel.com specifying whether you require it to be sent via a carrier (AVCO ExamService, RM SecureNet or WebXchange), via email or the JCQ Migration tool.
